Brief description of the proceedings of the committee:

The pre-selection procedure was conducted via e-mail. After reviewing the documentation submitted by the candidates, the Commission determined that the candidates had sent the complete set of required documents by the deadline indicated in the announcement and thus met the formal requirements of the competition. Subsequently, the Commission met online on May 16th using the Zoom platform and assessed the candidates in terms of the competition requirements, regarding their competence to perform specific tasks in the research project. In their motivation letters, the candidates declared themselves highly motivated and willing to quickly learn all the activities necessary for the project.

The Selection Commission shortlisted three candidates who met or exceeded the competition requirements and they were invited to the interviews to be scheduled using the Zoom platform as indicated in the table below.

Candidates were assessed applying the criteria listed below:

Criterion 1 the candidate's research achievements, including publications in prestigious academic press/journals (50% of the final score) 0-4 pts

Criterion 2 achievements resulting from the research projects, scholarships, awards and research experience gained at home or abroad, research workshops and training courses, participation in research projects (20% of the final score) 0-4 pts

Criterion 3the candidate's competence required to carry out specific tasks in the researchproject(30% of the final score)0-3 pts

Candidates will pass the assessment with at least 50%.

The three interviewed candidates ranked by score:

1 - Katarzyna Gorczyca	81.08%
2 - Agnieszka Michalak	46.85%
3 – Alicja Sikorska	43.24%
